# Bryn Seiont Newydd is a 71-bedroom, state-of-the-art, purpose-built care home in Caernarfon, Gwynedd.

The home, which is operated by Pendine Park Care Organisation, provides a variety of facilities for people whose lives have been affected by dementia. Bryn Seiont Newydd also won 'Best New Care Home – Elderly' at the Pinders Healthcare Design Awards.

The new building was constructed to provide a much needed Centre

of Excellence within the area, delivering a world-class, bilingual (English and Welsh) home that is the focus for community-based care with enclosed gardens, hair salon, day centre, music room and café. It also acts as a hub for other amenities including respite and day care, memory clinics as well as outreach services supporting people in their own homes.









The interior design team at Pendine Care wanted a floor that provided a homely, warm and welcoming atmosphere without sacrificing practicality, durability or ease of cleaning.

Honey Oak from Amtico's Spacia collection – with its golden shades and realistic oak grain – was chosen for use throughout the property. A Stripwood laying pattern allowed for a contemporary look that also fitted within design guidelines for dementia, providing good visibility and one continuous floor surface.

Calming environments for residents, visitors and staff have been created in the lobby area, dayrooms and 71 bedrooms as a result. Furthermore, the whole building benefits from a high performance finish and superb durability, thanks to Amtico Spacia's 0.55mm wear layer.

### **Department of Health guidelines**

The Department of Health provides a 'Health Building Note', which outlines the requirements for designing flooring in dementia environments. There are some highly important areas that need consideration, including vision and touch impairments, plus the support of safe kinaesthesia, balance and movement.

Floor materials and finishes should also be consistent across individual, public, activity and circulation spaces, while all finishes should be matt, non-reflective and non-patterned to help avoid confusion and encourage movement.

Additionally, internal flooring should have a non-slip and non-shiny texture to reduce slips, trips and falls, and provide reassurance especially to people with particular types of dementia. The flooring should also support easy rotation, turning, forward and reverse movements of wheelchairs.
