
Situated in East London, Royal Albert Dock is an exciting regeneration project worth £1.7bn.

The new commercial district boasts 4.7 million sq ft of office, residential, retail and leisure spaces. Developer ABP tasked design and build company Egg Group with creating different styles, and completing the fitout, for each floor of the four-storey Marketing Building.



When considering the raised access floor and the number of services below it, the team at Egg Group looked to Amtico's Access loose lay collection to provide a durable, yet stylish, floor that can be lifted and refitted as required. Access is designed to work seamlessly with other Amtico LVT collections, making it possible to create and define zones using different shape, colour and texture combinations. Egg Group created two bespoke Access designs; the sweeping linear grains of Dusky Walnut surround the kitchen area in a Pleat-inspired pattern, and rustic Sun Bleached Oak is laid in a Palisade-style.
